- All conditions of the ticket are to be read together with all other statements and / or directives either shown on the ticket, shown on the website (www.wakestock.co.uk) or displayed on the premises. A hard copy of the full conditions are available on request from the promoter.
 - Any ticket obtained in breach of these Terms and Conditions shall be void and all rights conferred or evidenced by such ticket shall be void. Any person seeking to use such a void ticket in order to gain or provide entry to the event may be considered to be a trespasser and may be liable to be ejected and liable to legal action.
 - In the event of a breach of contract by the supplier, the supplier shall not be liable for any loss, damage, cost or expense arising out of the breach which was not reasonably foreseeable by the supplier at the date of this contract.
 - Except where point (20) applies, tickets cannot be refunded or exchanged after purchase. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission if in the reasonable opinion of the promoter admission of the holder to the venue might be a risk to the safety of the audience and / or the holder and / or affect the enjoyment of the audience and / or the running of the concert, for example, if the holder appears to be under the influence of drink and / or drugs and / or is acting aggressively / is unable, when required, to produce proof of identity or age. No refunds will be given to ticket holders who are refused entry or ejected due to their own behaviour as suggested in, but not limited to, the examples above. Strictly no illegal substances. Persons entering the site may be searched.
 - No camping is allowed in the car parks and no sleeping in vehicles in the car parks is permitted. Camping is allowed on the site only in designated camping areas. Camping is only permitted with a weekend camping ticket. There is only one official Wakestock campsite – tents will be removed if they are found pitched outside of the official campsite, in the car park or in the nearby fields.
 - No camper vans will be admitted on the site without a camper van ticket. Camper van tickets must be purchased in advance and will not be available from the ticket office on site – there are a limited number available. Each person staying in the camper van must be in possession of a valid weekend camping ticket
 - Caravans and trailer tents will not be permitted on site.
 - All ticket holders must exchange their ticket for a wristband upon arrival – this must be worn at all times for the duration of the event.
 - No alcohol is allowed to be taken into the arena. Glass is not allowed to be taken onto any part of the site – Wakestock Ltd. reserves the right to remove anyone caught in possession of any glass items from the site and refuse admission. You are also prohibited from bringing any fireworks, weapons and other dangerous objects, tape / video recorders, and any other audio / video recording equipment onto the site.
 - In the event of inclement weather wear warm waterproof clothing.
 - No private sound systems will be permitted anywhere on site – the police and security contractor have the power to confiscate any sound systems which are found on site.
 - Please use the bins provided – fires are not permitted anywhere on site and will be extinguished.
 - There are disabled facilities on site, including a viewing platform for the main stage. Persons lost in the arena should meet at the box office on site.
 - No animals will be allowed onto the site.
- No person under the age of 16 will be allowed onto the site. If you are under 25 please note we operate a Challenge 25 policy which means anyone who appears to be under 25 will be asked for ID at the entrance. The only forms of ID we accept are a passport, driving license or one of the government approved proof of age cards which bears the PASS logo such as the Citizen Card. We do not accept photocopies of passports or driving licenses.
- Forged tickets or wristbands will not be accepted for entry to the venue and the law prohibits and penalises the production and distribution of such items and unofficial merchandise.
 - Strictly no trading is allowed on site, or at the Pwllheli Marina site without prior written permission from Wakestock Ltd and the correct passes.
 - Whilst every effort is made to ensure the full, advertised billing this ticket is for an event and not a specific artiste / band. Wakestock Ltd. reserves the right to change the bill or running time without prior notice.
 - In the event of cancellation of the festival by Wakestock Ltd. their liability for refund is limited to the face value of the ticket only. In the case of a partial cancellation refunds are at the Promoter's discretion.
 - Personal arrangements including travel, accommodation or hospitality relating to the event which have been arranged by the ticket holder are at their own risk.
 - Under no circumstances will duplicate tickets or wristbands be issued for lost tickets or wristbands etc. Keep your ticket safe.
 - Ticket holders consent to the photography, filming / sound recording of the event as members of the audience, which may be used for promotional purposes.
 - You release Wakestock and the sponsors of the event and it's contractors from all liability from loss or damage to person or property (save where injury to the person is brought about by their negligence) and you agree to comply with all rules and regulations relating to the venue and the event notified by Wakestock to you.
 - Wakestock shall not be liable for any items stolen or lost whilst on site. Please do not leave any valuable items in your tent. Valuables can be stored in the Cloakroom on site.
 - Tickets are security printed. Please keep it dry as to get it wet may invalidate it.
 - Tickets remain the property of the Promoter until payment is received in full.
 - Wakestock operates a zero tolerance policy on underage drinking – customers who are under 18 years old will be ejected from the festival site if found in possession of alcohol
 - Day tickets holders – please note there is no re-admission to the arena if you leave during the event.
